Concert Band Program

Freshwater State School offers students, in Years 4-6, an opportunity to experience a performance based concert band program. Students involved in the program receive 1 x instructional small group lesson and 1 x large band rehearsal lesson each week. Our school has two separate bands allowing for the differentiation in skill level amongst our students. All students learning an instrument are required to be an active member of a school band and commit to the many performances scheduled throughout the school calendar. Performances include: lunch time concerts, parades, local eisteddfods, school fete, presentation evenings, music evenings, Fanfare (Education Qld State-wide Musical Ensemble Competition – bi-annual).



Percussion Program

The Freshwater State School percussion program has students learning a variety of percussion instruments including xylophone, timpani along with drum kit. Students can begin learning percussion at the beginning of Year 4.

If accepted, students receive a weekly group lesson and when they have reached the appropriate level, the opportunity to join one of the school ensembles – Concert Band and Percussion Ensemble.
