This funding will be used to:

At Freshwater State School, we:

- guarantee that every student will either:
meet the National Minimum Standard (NMS) for their year level or;
have an evidenced based learning plan in place.
- ensure the following reading targets in P-3 are attained:
Prep – 90% of students achieve PM Level 9
Year 1 – 90% of students achieving PM Level 19
Year 2 – 90% of students achieving PM Level 25
Year 3 – 90% of students achieving PM Level 30
- Ensure the following Writing targets in Years 3 and 5 are attained:
NAPLAN writing mean above the Australian mean
50% of students achieve in the Upper Two Bands.

Our initiatives include:

- reviewing student performance data fortnightly for at risk students and every 5 weeks for all students
- implementing intensive research-based reading intervention support programs for identified students
- continuing to enhance our school's current P-2 reading program based on the explicit teaching of phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension (A. Bayetto BIG 6)
- extending the current P-2 reading program through to Year 6
- introducing the explicit teaching of comprehension strategies for fiction and non-fiction informative texts
- reviewing and refining the school's current writing program with a focus on the explicit teaching of vocabulary (A. Archer) and sentence/ paragraph structure
- implementing a school-based coaching program to develop teacher capacity aligned with the AITSL standards
- implementing daily writing sessions and weekly 'On Demand' writing
- monitoring writing outcomes every five weeks.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

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| • Increasing the Master Teacher fraction from 0.5 FTE to 1.0 FTE to support the implementation, monitoring, and review of the school's writing program. | \$60 000 |
| • Purchasing additional teacher aide time to assist with the delivery of intensive 1:1 reading intervention programs for students at risk of not reaching year level benchmarks. | \$175 000 |
| • Purchase TRS days to release teaching staff to work with the HOC to review and refine reading and writing data and programs. | \$22 961 |
