Boys Year Prep to Year 6

Shirts

Unisex polo shirt with school emblem in bottle green

Shorts

Unisex shorts in bottle green

Hat

Prep Students Lime green bucket hat.

Year 1-6 Bottle green bucket hat in bottle green

Shoes

mostly black joggers or school shoes with white socks is the preferred footwear requirement (no lights, glitter, roller balls etc.)



Girls Year Prep to Year 6

Shirts

Unisex polo shirt with school emblem in bottle green

Shorts

Unisex shorts in bottle green

Dress & Skort

dress in school check skort in bottle green

Hat

Prep Students Lime green bucket hat.

Year 1-6 Bottle green bucket hat in bottle green

Shoes

mostly black joggers or school shoes with white socks is the preferred footwear requirement (no lights, glitter, roller balls etc.)



Year 6 Senior Year

In recognition of the status of our Year 6 senior students, each Year 6 student is able to purchase a Senior Shirt available from the school uniform shop. The senior shirt may be worn in lieu of the standard uniform shirt and can be worn any school day.



Music Ensembles

It is a condition of being a member of a band or choir that members wear the specified music uniform at performance times or events. The music shirt can be worn in lieu of the standard uniform shirt and can be worn any school day. All students participating in Instrumental Music events must conform to the uniform standard which is; Freshwater Music shirt, long black pants (no tights/leggings) with black shoes and long black socks or knee length black skirts with black shoes and stockings. Girls must wear long hair tied back with a green and white ribbon.



Sports

Students are required to wear specified safety equipment as required by the Department of Education Manual or Sports Organiser. Students are permitted to wear representative school sport teams dress uniforms.

House Team Shirts



School Sports Days (Fun Run, Athletics Carnival)

Students are to wear designated sports uniform shirt, bottle green skort or shorts, appropriate year level hat and mostly black joggers is the preferred footwear option.

Name Tags

Please ensure all clothing items are clearly marked with your child's name.

School & Library Bag

- Library Bags (compulsory prep Year 2) bottle green, waterproof with school emblem
- School Bag an ergonomically friendly back pack is available in school colours with the school emblem

Winter Wear

Winter Jacket – A winter jacket is available at the uniform shop, alternatively one can be worn in school colours.



Body Art

Students are not to attend school wearing fake tattoos, nail polish and/or make-up. Students wearing these items will be requested to remove them.

Hair

Hair is to be clean and tidy at all times. Hair must be maintained in a manner that ensures the safety of the student and others e.g. long hair neatly tied back with school coloured ribbon or band. No excessive adornments permitted e.g. no headbands with bobbles or other attachments.

Jewellery

- ear studs or sleepers are allowed.
- a watch (not smart) may be worn however the student must take full responsibility for its safe keeping.

Neck-chains, rings, anklets etc are not permitted due to safety reasons.

Sun Protection

To ensure protection from the sun, the school has adopted a style of hat which is mandatory for outdoor activities and the wearing of sunscreen is encouraged. The school provides sunscreen but parents may choose to supply their own.

Camps

Our school camping program involves physical indoor and outdoor activities and it is important that appropriate and safe clothing is worn. Children must conform with the clothing lists provided for camp. (e.g. no sleeveless shirts to be worn.)

Excursions

Children are required to adhere to uniform mode of dress when representing the school e.g. competitions, performances, excursions etc.

Swimming

Sun safety is to be observed at all times. Boys are to wear sun shirt and speedos/boardshorts or a one-piece sunsuit. Girls are to wear a sun shirt over their swimmers.

School Leaders

As school leaders (School and House Captains, Vice Captains and Student Councillors) are role models for other students, they are to adhere to the uniform mode of dress and wear their badge at all times.

Signing Shirts

Students who are transferring from our school can request other students to write goodbye messages on one shirt if their parent gives them permission. No other students can have their shirts signed until they are transferring from or leaving Freshwater State School.
