## This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students identified as requiring support are mapped on the Personal and Social Capability Learning continuum
- Ensure that 100% of teachers have universal student well-being strategies that align to the Student Well-being Framework
- Ensure that 90% of students achieve A – C in English
- Ensure that 60% of students achieve an A/B in English
- Ensure that students who are not reaching our A-C targets have a Personalised Learning Plan or an ICP where required
- Ensure that 100% of students that require a complex case team are identified and supported
- Ensure that Classroom Teaching Staff have Support Teachers that co -plan and co -teach to support students requiring focused or intensive teaching
- Ensure all Prep's and new Year 1-3' students have an entry Early Start assessment by the end of term 1

## Our initiatives include

- Collect baseline student and staff data to inform well-being systems and processes.
- Implement Coaching and mentoring framework
- Continue to refine our Student Services System with a focus on evidence based inclusive practice
- Refine our support model where differentiation is prioritised through a co -teaching and co- planning approach
- Develop and formalise an evidence -based, inclusive, high yield literacy pedagogy based on the Gradual Release of Responsibility.
- Refine the vertical alignment of units in the whole school curriculum plan
- Grow staff and leader's knowledge of inclusive pedagogical theories, approaches, practices and strategies
- Grow staff and leader's data literacy skills and practice.
